Dublin proved to be the perfect setting for this year's QS Higher Ed Summit: Europe 2023, with many Irish universities celebrating their success in the QS World University Rankings 2024, which were previewed at an exclusive evening reception for delegates several hours before the official release on 27 June.

Higher Education Minister Simon Harris welcomed the scrutiny placed on institutions by rankings and announced that Ireland's strategy on international education is due to be released in the coming weeks.


Here is a selection of our key Summit takeaways:

- Universities have a moral responsibility to be the agents of sustainable transformation in society through collective action. **Green skills** will become a crucial part of the learning experience, echoing the ways in which digital skills became vital over the last two decades.
- 12% of UK students will experience homelessness, with one suitable bed in university-owned accommodation for every seven UK students. With the majority of students having to navigate the private rental market, it's crucial for institutions to develop a robust housing strategy as part of their student recruitment plans.
- Erasmus+ has been the main driver of global mobility, facilitating the mobility of **650,000 students**, but universities are facing challenges in managing mobilities effectively, which requires investment in digital tools to streamline and facilitate these processes.
- The interconnectedness of the **UN's SDGs** means you have to tackle them in a multidisciplinary way, using behavioural science to

ensure we bring society with us, leaning on the fact that universities are highly-trusted and respected institutions.






